We hope that the Medley will appear more frequently and will improve in guality in the course of time. This can only be achieved if our members will give us their support and send in their contributions and suggestions. The success of the Medley depends on the enthusiasm of our members.

## SOCIETY MEETINGS

On 16 February, Mr. Lee Guan Parr of the Research-Statistics Unit Ministry of National Development addressed the Society on "Mathematical modelling in urban transportation planning".

Our last year's president, Professor P.H.Diananda, delivered his presidential address on 28 February, immediately after the Annual General Meeting. The address was entitled: "Two problems in elementary geometry".

On 24 April, Dr. Leong Yu Kiang of the "niversity of Singapore spoke to the Society on "An isomorphism problem for finite nilpotent groups". An abstract of his talk can be found on page 16.

On 21 June, Professor Basil C. Bennie of James Cooke University, Australia gave a lecture entitled "Moments in the South Pacific".

Under a joint sponsorship by the Society and the Singapore National Academy of Science, Professor E.M. Patterson gave a talk on "A personal view on research in mathematics", on 29 June.
