3. Interschool Mathematical Competition 1982

The Competition was held on 3 July 1982 at Anglo-Chinese Junior College. A total of 306 students from 9 junior colleges and 45 secondary schools took part in the Competition. Hwa Chong Junior College was awarded the Singapore Mathematical Society Challenge Shield for the third consecutive year and was allowed to keep the Shield. Kang Sing Bing and Hock Kai Meng shared the Southeast Asian Mathematical Society Prize of \$250. Successful individual candidates (ranking 1 to 5) received cash prizes and book vouchers. Members of the successful teams (ranking 1 to 3) received book vouchers.

The prize-giving ceremony was held on 17 August 1982 at Lecture Theatre 22, Faculty of Science, National University of Singapore. Prof Masayoshi Nagata of Kyoto University gave away the prizes and delivered a lecture (see 2(d)).

4. Annual High School Mathematics Examination

The Society sponsored the Annual High School Mathematics Examination which was conducted by the Ministry of Education, and coordinated by Mr Willie Yong, as a survey test to all Pre-University I Science and some selected Pre-University I Arts, Commerce and Secondary 4 pupils in August 1982.

IV. INTERNATIONAL MATHEMATICAL UNION ROLL AND MEDICAL UNION ROLL AND

Prof Lee Peng Yee represented the Society at the General Assembly of the International Mathematical Union (IMU) in Warsaw, Poland, on 8 and 9 August 1982. The Executive Committee of IMU has decided to hold the International Congress of Mathematicians in Warsaw from 16 to 24 August 1983.

The Society's annual contribution to IMU has been raised from Sw. Frs. 600 to Sw. Frs. 850, effective from 1 January 1983.

V. GRANTS

The Society received a donation of \$6,000 from the Lee Kong Chian Centre of Mathematical Research for the Society's activities in 1982/1983.

VI. LIBRARY

There was only one request for the use or loan of the Society's collection of books.
