TRAVEL GRANTS FOR YOUNG MATHEMATICIANS

The International Mathematical Union will award travel grants to young Mathematicians to help them attend the ICM-86, Berkeley, California, August 3 – 11 1986. The grants are intended primarily for young mathematicians from developing countries (not necessarily members of IMU), but applications from countries with strict monetary regulations will also be considered.

The age-limit for the grants is 35 years. The candidates should present evidence of research work on post-doctoral level (such as publications in journals or preprints), and they would be able to benefit from the interaction with mathematicians from other countries attending the Congress.

In addition to the name and address of the candidate, the applications should contain a brief curriculum vitae plus a list of publications and preprints.

The International Congress of Mathematicians will waive the registration fee of the grantees and provide a special allowance to cover their board and lodging.
