Hwa Chong Junior College was awarded the Singapore Mathematical Society Challenge Shield. Loke Hung Yean was awarded the Southeast Asian Mathematical Society Prize. Successful individual candidates (ranking 1 to 5) received cash prizes and book vouchers. Members of the successful teams (ranking 1 to 3) received book vouchers.

The prize-giving ceremony was held on 12 September 1985 at Lecture Theatre 24, Faculty of Science, National University of Singapore. Prof Brian Hartley, Visiting Professor at the National University of Singapore, gave away the prizes and delivered a lecture (see 2(d)).

IV Singapore Topology Conference

The Department of Mathematics, National University of Singapore, and the Society jointly organised a "Singapore Topology Conference" at the National University of Singapore from June 10 to 15, 1985. The Conference was preceded by a Workshop from June 4 to 8.

Two workshops were conducted: "Homology of groups" by Prof P J Hilton and "Algebraic K-theory" by Dr A J Berrick. The lecture notes will be published in the Southeast Asian Bulletin of Mathematics. There were 34 lectures given at the Conference. The Conference Proceedings will be published as a special issue of the North Holland journal "Topology and its Applications". 21 contributed papers have been received and are being reviewed.

The Conference attracted 80 participants from 23 countries and the workshop was attended by more than 30 people. 14 participants were sponsored by SEAMS with financial support from Unesco.

A Conference Dinner was held at Hotel Equatorial.

Major financial support was provided by the Lee Foundation through the Lee Kong Chian Centre for Mathematical Research and the Singapore Turf Club. Additional assistance came from the Society, Shell Eastern Petroleum Ltd, British Council and Fraser & Neave (S) Pte Ltd.

Members of the Organising Committee were Prof Malcolm J Wicks (Chairman), Dr A Jon Berrick (Secretary), Dr Thomas Bier, Dr Fred P F Leung and Dr Ng Tze Beng.

V Workshop on Linear Algebra and its Teaching

The Workshop was proposed by the School Subcommittee in view of the introduction of the new "Syllabus C" for G.C.E. A—Level Mathematics and Further Mathematics in 1986. It was jointly organised with the Department of Mathematics, National University of Singapore and was held on September 9 and 10, 1985 at Lecture Theatre 24, Faculty of Science, National University of Singapore.

Lectures covering history, contents, applications and teaching of linear algebra relevant to the school situations were delivered at the Workshop by the following invited speakers: Prof Chong Chi Tat (NUS), Dr Koh Khee Meng (NUS), Dr Fred Leung Pui Fai (NUS), Dr Brett T McInnes (NUS), Dr T R Nanda (NUS), Dr Ong Sit Tui (Institute of Education, Singapore), Dr Eric Plant (Institute of Education, Singapore) and Dr Tan Sie Keng (NUS).

The Workshop was attended by more than 100 people consisting mainly of teachers from junior colleges.

VI Election of Mr Chan Kai Yau as Honorary Member

Mr Chan Kai Yau was elected as an Honorary Member of the Society in recognition of his long service to the Society, first as a Secretary in the early years of the Society and later as a Vice-President of the Society.
