3. Activities

a. Publications

The Society published the SMO 2023 solution book (edited by Dr Teo Kok Ming, A/P Toh Tin Lam, Dr Lau Jing Feng and Dr Tay Tiong Seng).

b. Lectures

- The SMS Lecture Series "Mathematics of Dynamic Processes: Forecasting the Future" by Professor Juan-Pablo Ortega Lahuerta (NTU) was held on March 10, 2023, from 4-5pm in NUS LT27. It was well attended with more than 120 participants.
- The SMS Public Lecture titled "Dr Arthur Benjamin Mathemagician" by Dr Arthur Benjamin was held on March 24, 2023 in NUS LT27 from 5.15-6.45pm. It attracted more than 250 people, including many young children.

c. Singapore Mathematical Olympiad

• The Society conducted Round 1 and Round 2 of the Singapore Mathematical Olympiad (Junior, Senior and Open Sections) in May and June 2023. A total of 8641 students from 127 secondary schools and junior colleges participated in the various sections of the Olympiad.

- For Junior Section, there were 3852 participants from 102 schools. For Senior Section, there were 2900 participants from 103 schools. For Open Section, there were 1889 participants from 58 schools.

d. International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO)

g. Singapore Mathematical Project Festival

- The Singapore Mathematics Project Festival 2023 attracted 23 projects from Junior section and 29 projects from Senior section. Judging panels, made up of mathematicians, were formed to grade the project and presentation of each team. The grades were used as a reference for short-listing the projects for the final round. Consequently, 4 teams from the Junior Section and 5 teams from the Senior Section were invited for the final round.

i. SEAMS

Dr Hang Kim Hoo delivered a lecture on 'The Future of Mathematics and Mathematics Education in Singapore' at the SEAMS Hanoi Forum 2023 -Southeast Asian Mathematics in 21st Century, and also attended the SEAMS Council Meeting, both through zoom on May 22, 2023.

j. The International Council for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (ICIAM) Presidents' Meeting and Board Meeting

k. Enrichment Programmes in Mathematics

- Primary Mathematics Olympiad Programme (PMOP) The Society conducted PMOP in June and November. There was a total of 286 students in 10 groups.
- Secondary Enrichment Programme SMS conducted 2 sessions (4 hours) for Yuan Chin Secondary School, 2 sessions (4 hours) for River Valley High School, and 2 sessions (4 hours) for Paya Lebar Methodist Girls' School.

1. Singapore Science & Engineering Fair (SSEF)

SMS supported the annual SSEF2023 with the SMS Special Award for Ingenuity for mathematics projects. The SSEF is an annual event organized by MOE and Science Centre Singapore. The SSEF is a national competition for research projects done by full-time students up to the Junior College level. This SMS Special Award for Ingenuity was awarded to one individual and two teams. The individual project was from NUS High School of Math and Science, titled "On the Applications of Inequalities Containing Sums of Minimum/Maximum of Numbers". One team project was titled "The Steiner Tree Problem ", from Hwa Chong Institution. The other team project was by students from Eunoia and Temasek Junior Colleges, titled "SSP: An Alternative Perspective to NTRU". The following members from SMS helped in the judging of the Mathematics Projects for this award: Dr Hang Kim Hoo, Dr Tang Wee Kee and Mr Hang Hao Chuien.

m. Teachers' workshops

An SMS Workshop for Teachers - Student Preparation for Mathematical Olympiad, was organised on 30 August 2023 at NUS Science Faculty S17 05-11. A total of 27 teachers from 18 secondary schools/junior colleges participated in this workshop which was conducted by Dr Hang Kim Hoo and Mr Wang Haibin.

n. SMS blog

The SMS blog was launched in 2022 and it aims to promote mathematical conversations among the mathematics community, locally and beyond. The intended audience are students from schools (upper secondary school and above) and tertiary institutions. The first post in 2023 was titled "A Puzzle on a Glass of Water" and announced in January. Two further blogs were posted in March and May.

4. SMS Prizes in Mathematics

- The **Singapore Mathematical Society Gold Medal and Book Prize** 2023 at NUS was awarded to Ho Wei Haw, a student in Mathematics with First Class Honours and best overall performance in Mathematics.
- The Singapore Mathematical Society Gold Medal and Book Prize 2023 at NTU was awarded to Teh Yu Xuan, a student in the School of Physical and Mathematical Sciences with First Class Honours and best overall performance in Mathematical Sciences.
- The **Singapore Mathematical Society Medal in Mathematical Sciences** 2023 at NTU was awarded to Lei Qian, who was a graduate student with the best PhD thesis in Mathematical Sciences in NTU.
- The **Singapore Mathematical Society Book Prize** 2023 at NIE was awarded to Chew Wei Sheng, the best student teacher (Secondary Track) in Mathematics in the Bachelor of Science (Education) Programme.
- The Singapore Mathematical Society Book Prize for Engineering Mathematics 2023 at Temasek Polytechnic was awarded to Yoong Wai Kit, the best Mathematics student from Engineering School.
- The Singapore Mathematical Society Special Award for Ingenuity for mathematics projects at SSEF was awarded to an individual and two teams from NUS High School of Math and Science, Hwa Chong Institution, Eunoia and Temasek Junior Colleges.
