a. Publications

d. Singapore Mathematical Olympiad

- The Society conducted the Singapore Mathematical Olympiad (Junior, Senior and Open Sections) in June 2017. A total of 7613 students from 124 secondary schools and junior colleges participated in the various sections of the Olympiad.
- For Junior Section, there were 3611 participants from 98 schools. For Senior Section, there were 2339 participants from 92 schools. For Open Section, there were 1663 participants from 69 schools. In addition, there were 186 participants from Indonesia and Vietnam.
- In collaboration with the Vietnamese Mathematical Society, the Society conducted round 1 and 2 of SMO in Hanoi. A total of 139 students from 46 schools in different parts of Vietnam took part in the competition.

e. International Mathematical Olympiad

- The 58th International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO) was held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil from 12 to 23 July 2017. A total of 615 contestants from 111 countries or regions participated in this IMO.

h. Singapore Mathematics Symposium

• SMS organized the Eighth Singapore Mathematics Symposium on 29th September 2017 at School of Physical and Mathematical Sciences.

- The symposium featured 4 speakers –Van Vu, from NUS Department of Mathematics, Dong Fengming from NTU National Institute of Education, Yap Von Bing from NUS Department of Statistic and Applied Probability, and Thomas Peyrin from NTU School of Physical and Mathematical Sciences.
- There was also a poster competition participated by graduate students from NUS and NTU. Ng Hong Wai from NTU School of Physical and Mathematical Sciences and Ruixue Zhang from NTU National Institute of Education were selected by the panel of judges to be the winners of the poster competition.
- The organizing committee for the Eighth Singapore Mathematics Symposium were Chan Song Heng(Chair), Chan Hock Peng and Gan Wee Teck.

i. Singapore Mathematical Project Festival

- The Singapore Mathematics Project Festival 2017 attracted a total of 48 projects (from 15 schools). Judging panels, made up of mathematicians and school teachers, were formed to grade the presentation of each team. The grades were used as a reference for short-listing the projects for the final round. Consequently, 5 teams from the Junior Section and 5 teams from the Senior Section were invited to the Festival Congress held at NUS on 1st April 2017.
- To encourage students to participate in the final congress other than the few teams selected for the final presentation, a prize presentation was held for the non-shortlist projects for Bronze / Honorable Mention / Excellent Presentation Prizes.

j. SMS Essay Competition 2017

- The Society organized the 7th SMS essay competition with the theme "Mathematics and Big Data". The competition was officially launched on 10 March 2017 during the SMS Lecture Series. In view of the burgeoning field of data science, the competition aimed to expose the students to this novel field and to let the students discover applications of Mathematics in various aspects of Big Data.
- The Society received a total of 60 entries from 17 schools with 13 entries for Category A (secondary 1 & 2 or equivalent), 31 for Category B (Secondary 3 & 4 or equivalent), and 16 for Category C (JC or equivalent).

k. Mathematics Teachers Conference 2017

- The Society supported the Association of Mathematics Educators and the Mathematics & Mathematics Education Academic Group of NIE in the organization of the Mathematics Teachers Conference 2017 on 1st June 2017.
- The theme of the conference was Mathematics Instruction: Goals, Tasks and Activities. The conference attracted over 600 participants, most of whom were local mathematics teachers. A/P Yap Von Bing delivered a keynote Dr Hang Kim Hoo also conducted a workshop for Junior College teachers while A/P Toh Tin Lam conducted a workshop for Secondary School teachers.

m. Silkroad Mathematics Center

- The Second Meeting of the Steering Committee was convened on April 17, 2017 at Academy of Mathematics and System Sciences, Chinese Academy of Sciences, Beijing. SMS's President attended the meeting as founding members of SMC.
- SMS nominated two invited speakers Hoang Viet Ha and Yu Shih-Hsien, and five junior mathematicians: Su Chunmei, Yang Zhiguo, Quek Jia Hao, Ruan Xinran and Zhao Quan to participate in the International Conference on Partial Differential Equations, the inaugural conference of SMC Series International Conferences.

n. Enrichment Programmes in Mathematics

- Primary Mathematics Olympiad Programme (PMOP) SMS conducted the programme in June and December at NUS respectively. Altogether 257 students attended the programme.
- Talent Outreach Programme (SMS-TOP) The Society conducted three modules of enrichment programmes on Geometry, Combinatorics and Programming.
- Secondary Enrichment Programme
 SMS conducted 6 sessions of enrichment courses/talks for MOE Gifted Programme in 2017. In addition, the Society also conducted another 9 sessions of enrichment classes for five different secondary schools (CHIJ St. Nicolas Girls' School, Catholic High School, Unity Secondary School, River Valley High School, Paya Lebar Methodist Girls' School (Secondary), Singapore Chinese Girls' School, Temasek Junior College, Catholic High School).
