(d) Mathematical Symposium. A one-day mathematical symposium was held on May 30, 1979. This programme was held in conjunction with Nanyang University and the University of Singapore, with some financial support from the Ministry of Education. The symposium formed part of the First Franco-Southeast Asian Mathematical Conference. The following lectures were given
