1. Singapore Group Theory Conference 1987

2. Training Camp for the Olympiad

Prizes are awarded for both team and individual performance (each team has three members). A new prize is introduced this year, to be awarded to a secondary school participant of sufficient merit.

4. Statistics Workshop for School Teachers

The Society's school subcommittee is organising a teachers' workshop on hypothesis testing and non-parametric statistics, to be held in September.

5. NUS Mathematics Department Open House

The National University of Singapore Mathematics Department is having an open house on Saturday, 10 October, from 9.30 am to 4.30 pm. The programme includes talks, video/film presentations, and an exhibition. There will be exhibits on the use of computers in mathematics, and on the history of the Fields Medal.
